In order to give the Company the flexibility to repurchase Shares if and when appropriate, an ordinary resolution will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to approve the grant of a new general mandate to the Directors to purchase Shares on the Stock Exchange of a total number of up to 10% of the total number of the Shares in issue as at the date of passing of such resolution at the Annual General Meeting (the “Share Repurchase Mandate”).

The Directors wish to state that they have no immediate plan to repurchase any Shares pursuant to the Share Repurchase Mandate.

An explanatory statement required by the Listing Rules to provide the Shareholders with requisite information reasonably necessary for them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the granting of the Share Repurchase Mandate is set out in Appendix A to this circular.

In order to give the Company the flexibility to issue Shares if and when appropriate, an ordinary resolution will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to approve the grant of a new general mandate to the Directors to allot, issue or deal with additional Shares of a total number of up to 10% of the total number of the Shares in issue as at the date of passing of such resolution at the Annual General Meeting (the “Share Issuance Mandate”). An ordinary resolution to extend the Share Issuance Mandate by adding the total number of the Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to the Share Repurchase Mandate will also be proposed at the Annual General Meeting.

The following is the explanatory statement required by the Listing Rules to provide the Shareholders with requisite information reasonably necessary for them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the ordinary resolution to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting in relation to the Share Repurchase Mandate.

(1) Share Capital

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the Company had 2,477,902,351 Shares in issue. Subject to the passing of ordinary resolution No. 4 set out in the notice of the Annual General Meeting and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased by the Company prior to the Annual General Meeting, the Directors would be authorised under the Share Repurchase Mandate to repurchase, during the period in which the Share Repurchase Mandate remains in force, a total number of 247,790,235 Shares, representing 10% of the total number of Shares in issue as at the date of the Annual General Meeting.

(2) Reasons for Share Repurchases

The Directors believe that the proposed granting of the Share Repurchase Mandate is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at that time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value per Share and/or earnings per Share. Pursuant to an announcement made on 2 February 2016, Huada entered into an acting-in-concert agreement with Dr. Yeh Tsuei Chi ("Dr. Yeh"), Director and Chief Executive Officer of the Company. Upon the full vesting and exercise of the share and share options of Dr. Yeh, Huada/CEC and Dr. Yeh will together hold an aggregate of 718,278,000 Shares/share options of the Company representing approximately 28.9% of the total number of Shares of the Company in issue.

On the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased prior to the Annual General Meeting, in the event that the Directors exercise the proposed Share Repurchase Mandate in full, the shareholding of Huada/CEC and Dr. Yeh would be increased to approximately 32.1% of the total number of Shares of the Company in issue.
